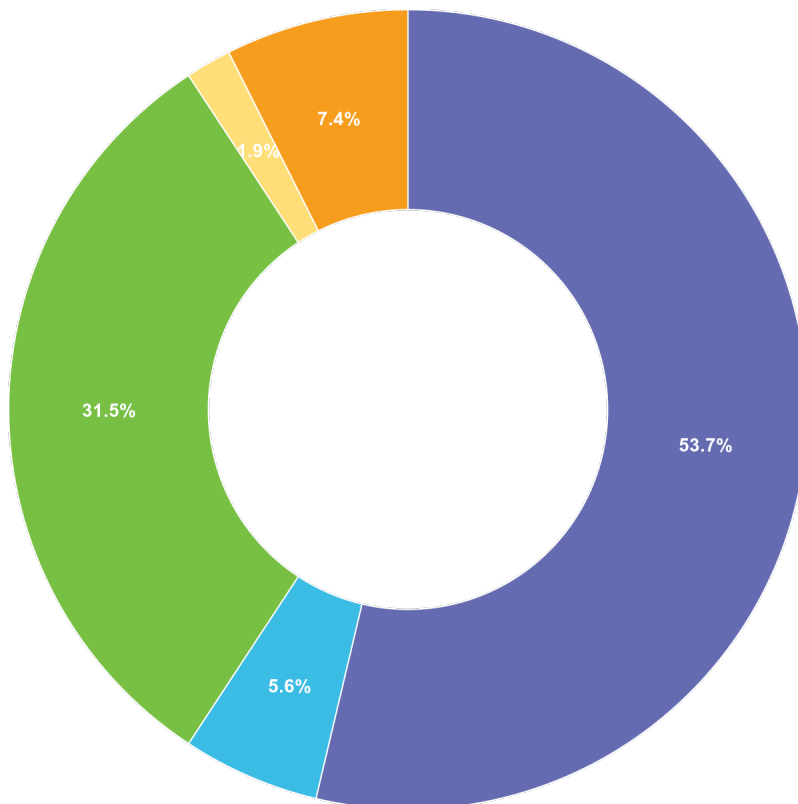

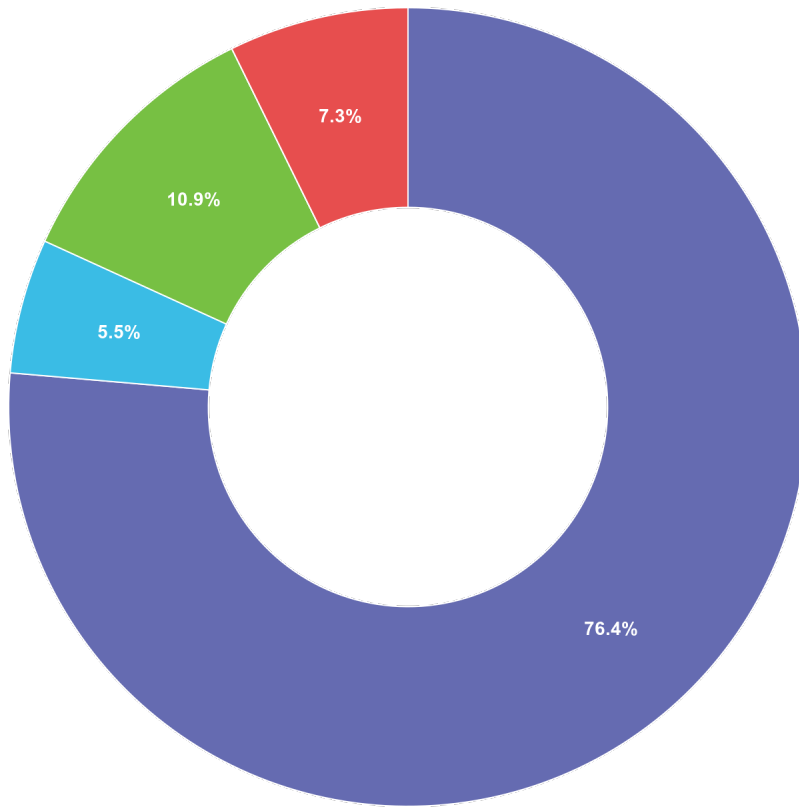

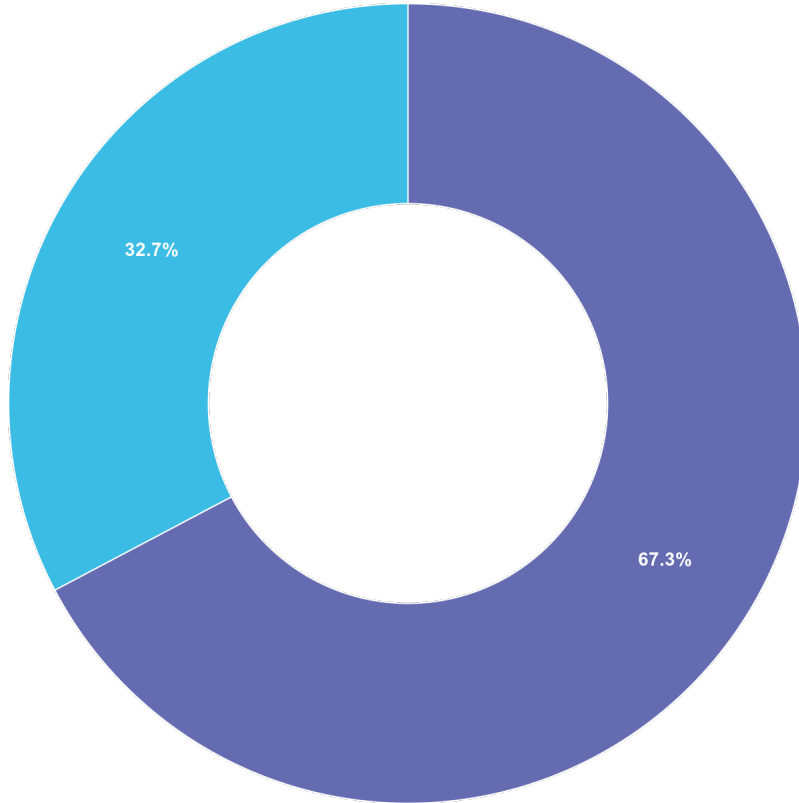
I'd like to hear how members of the community describe specific issues. I don't have any opportunity to be aware of any particular programs that would help bridge relations between the community and the police department that serves it.

Q6 Do you think the Sag Harbor Police Dept. should respond to Mental Health calls ?

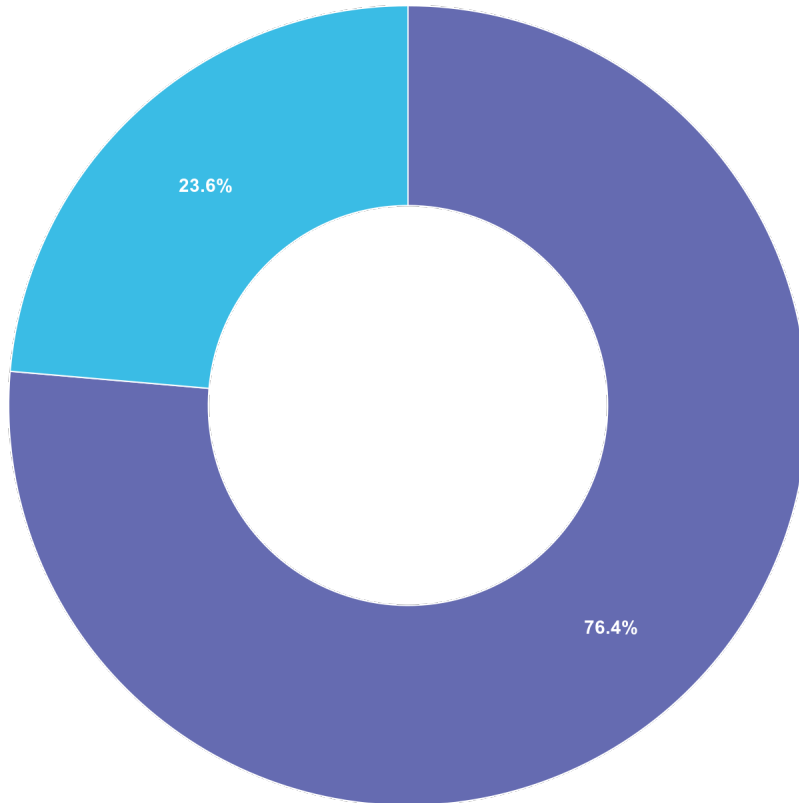

overdose calls ?

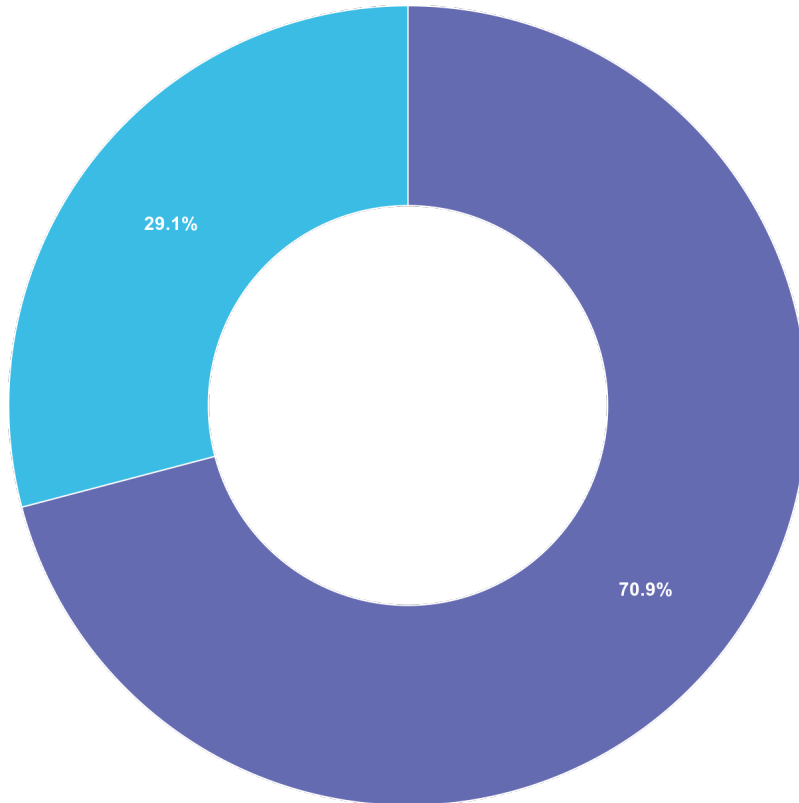

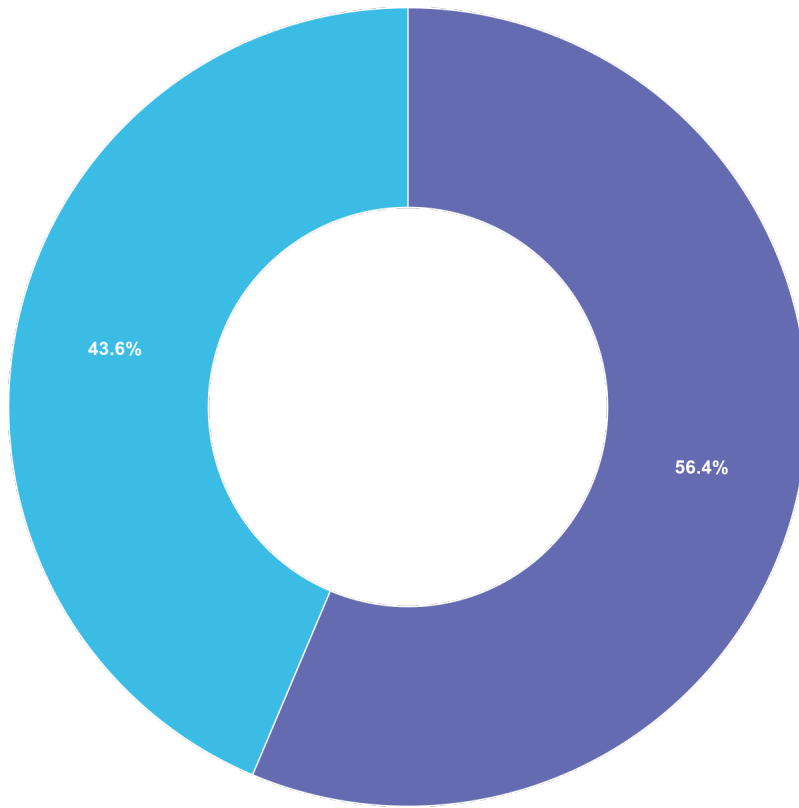

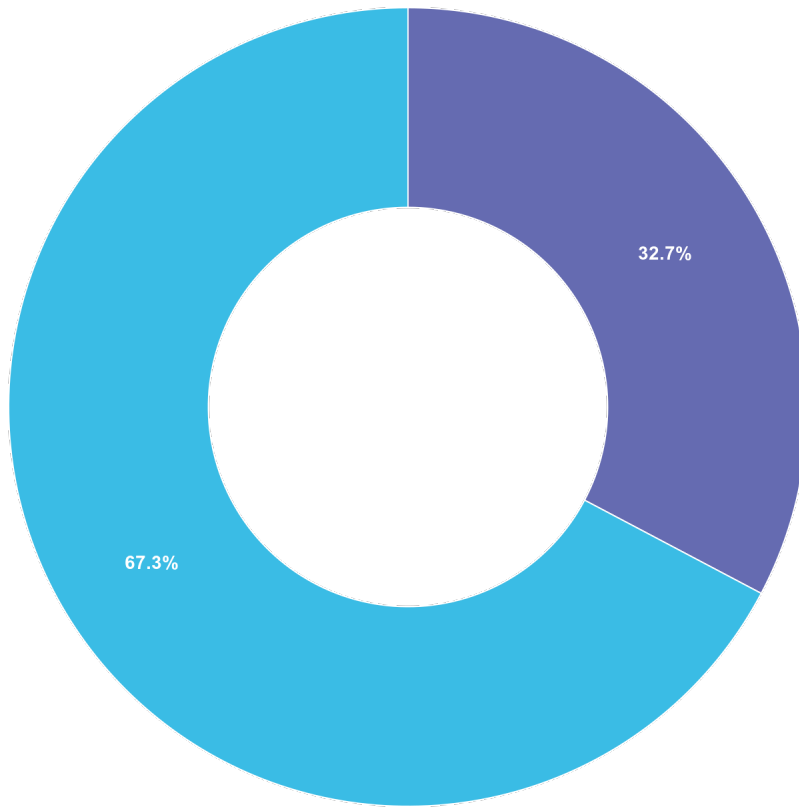
Q9 Do you think the Sag Harbor Police should have a presence in the school ?

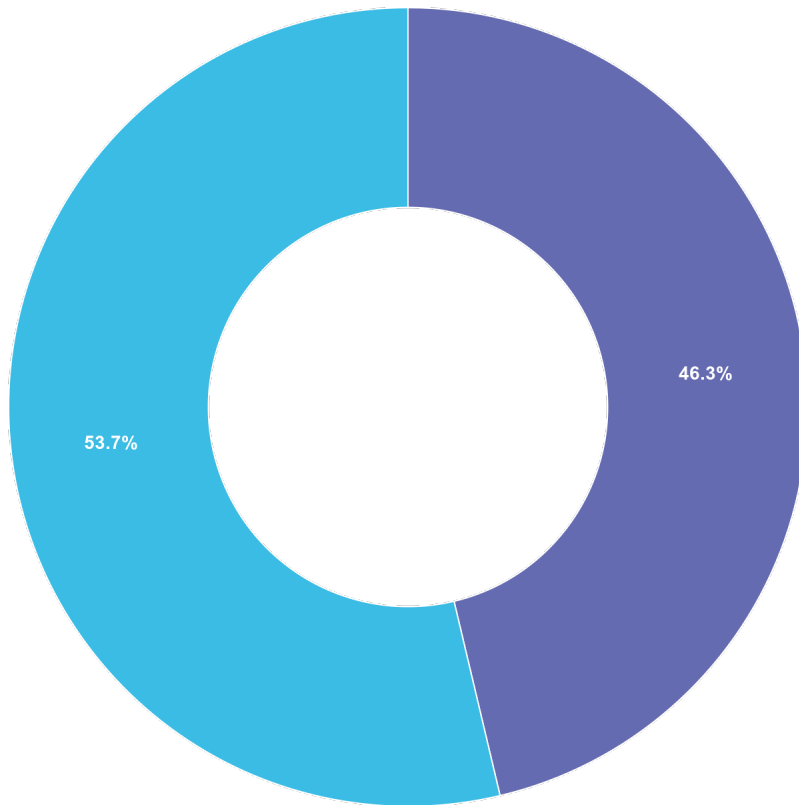
Q10 Do you have a child/children in the Sag Harbor School District ?

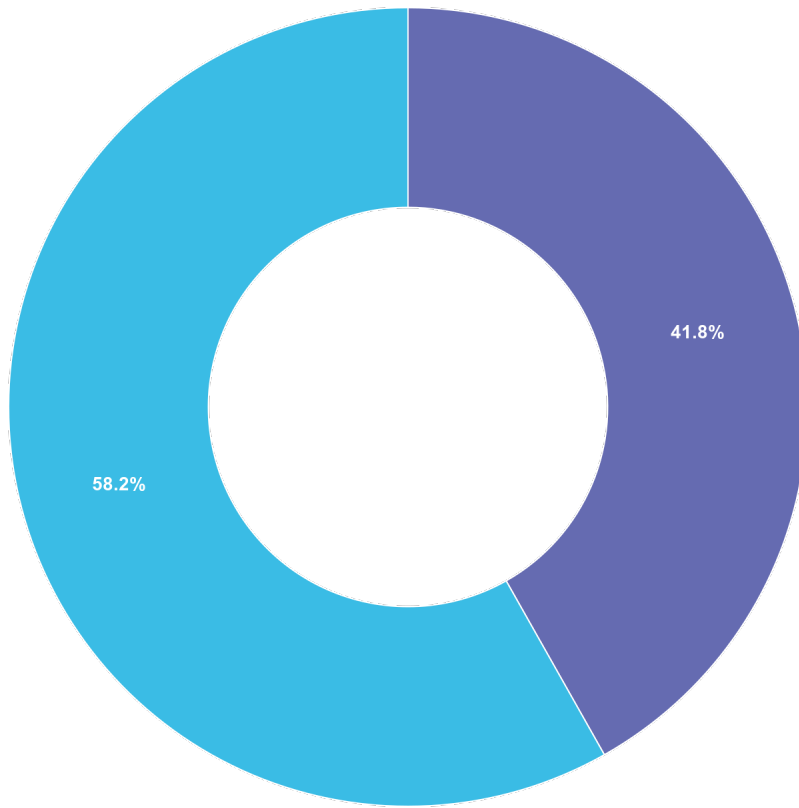
Q11 Do you think there are some other areas in which Village residents turn to the Sag Harbor Police to handle, that may better be addressed by others ?

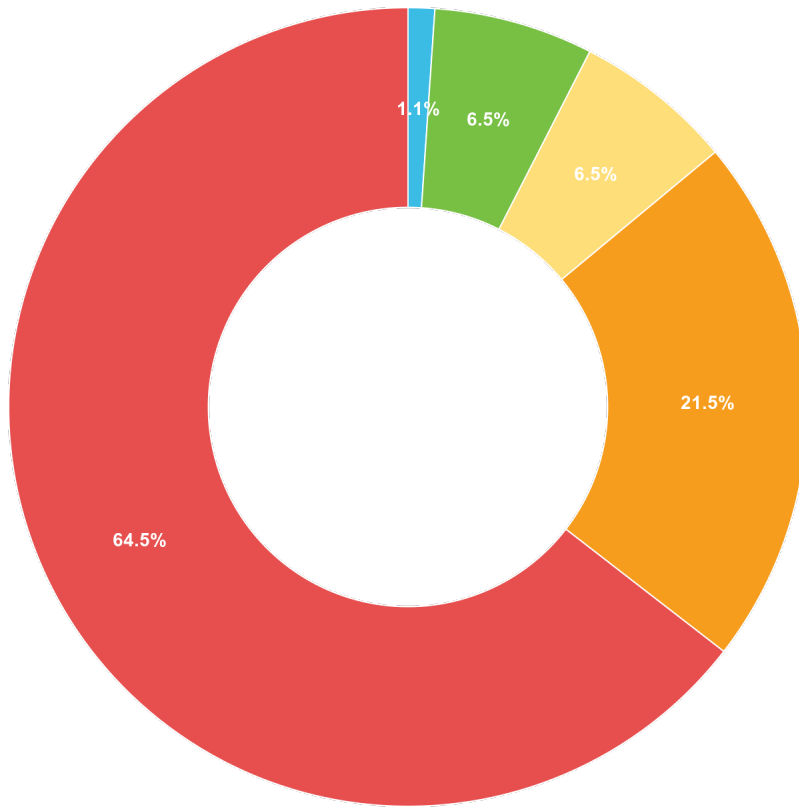
