The Village Public Education and Outreach program will be tailored to describe topics related to the impacts of storm water discharges on local water bodies, pollutants of concern and their sources, and the steps that can be taken to reduce pollutants in storm water runoff and non-storm water discharges. The Village's program will make special note of the discharge of pathogens to Sag Harbor and Sag Harbor Cove.

Due to the seasonal nature of many of the homes and residents in the Village, typical Phase II measures are not always effective or efficient. As a result, the Village has chosen to evaluate the number of kiosks/displays of storm water information as an indicator for measuring the overall effectiveness of the Village's compliance with the Public Education and Outreach program requirements. There are three kiosks/displays of storm water information in the Village.
