

Paid Parking Rates & Procedures

- **Hours:** Parking from 12 am until 10 am shall be free of charge.
- **Parking App:** Every driver parking on Long Wharf shall initiate a parking session with ParkMobile (the vendor administering the paid parking program), **except those drivers who are exempt from paid parking.** Sessions may be initiated by:
 - (i) using the ParkMobile web-based application,
 - (ii) calling ParkMobile's toll free number from your personal phone or from the Village's phone that will be available at the Harbor Master's office on Long Wharf. After 10 am, a parking session must be initiated with Parkmobile regardless of the length of intended stay.
- **Parking Fees:** The first hour of every parking session shall be free of charge. All hours after the first free hour will be \$4.00 per hour.
- **Time Limits:** All parking sessions initiated before 6:00 pm will be for a maximum of 3 hours. All parking sessions initiated after 6:00 PM will be for a maximum of 5 hours.
- **Form of Payment:** Parking payment will be by credit or debit card. Payments will be made through the smartphone ParkMobile APP or by dialing the ParkMobile toll free number. A telephone for this purpose will be available to the public at the Harbor master's office on Long Wharf.

Exemptions from Paid Parking Regulations

- All handicapped parking stalls utilized by individuals with valid New York State handicapped stickers and all parking stalls with parking limits of thirty (30) minutes or less are exempt from paid parking. Existing parking time limits remain applicable to the handicapped and thirty (30) minute stalls.
- All vehicles displaying a volunteer Sag Harbor Fire Department of Sag Harbor Volunteer Ambulance Corps placard shall be exempt from paid parking regulations provided the individual parking the vehicle is an active member of either one or both volunteer organizations. Existing parking time limits remain applicable to the parking stalls where the volunteer is parked unless the vehicle is there because the volunteer is actively engaged in an emergency response and has not yet been able to return to the vehicle.
